Comment:

The timing of adapting the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code is wrong. The biggest changes seem to be to the residential chapter (compared to the 2006 IECC).

- 1. It will increase the cost of design.**
- 2. It will increase the cost of construction, in labor, materials and the required testing.**
- 3. Most importantly, the cost to the end user, the home owner, will increase.**
