# 2018 International Energy Conservation Code Training

- ❖ Service water heating requirements
- ❖ High efficacy lighting requirements

Half Day Commercial IECC Training:

- ❖ Building envelope (insulation and glazing)
- ❖ Air sealing requirements including the continuous air barrier
- ❖ HVAC requirements focused on single zone unitary systems
- ❖ Service water heating requirements
- ❖ Lighting power density and control requirements including daylighting
