Nevada Clean Energy Corps



The Nevada Governor's Office of Energy is seeking ten full-time AmeriCorps members to serve in the Nevada Clean Energy Corps. The program is 30 – 40 hours a week and members can work a flexible schedule including nights and weekends in order to fulfill their 1,700 hour commitment.

Member Responsibilities will include:

- Provide energy efficiency outreach to residents of northern Nevada.
- Conduct residential and commercial energy audits.
- Assist with installation of energy efficiency measures.
- Track homes reached and equipment installed to document energy savings.

Qualifications of preferred candidate:

- Willingness to work closely with a small team;
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills;
- Must be over 18 years of age;
- Must be a US citizen that has received a high school diploma or GED;
- Degree, certificate or experience in an environmental or engineering field preferred
- Must be available for the entire year-long service period and able to serve on a full-time basis.

Compensation:

Nevada Clean Energy Corps members are funded by the Corporation for National and Community Service and Nevada Volunteers. In return for their service, AmeriCorps members receive a modest living allowance, basic health insurance, and will be eligible for an education award at the successful completion of service. The 2015 living allowance for full-time year-round service is \$12,500 with an education award of \$5,500. The living allowance is paid to the member weekly at \$240 per payment. The education award is only eligible to members that complete the entire 1700 hour term of service.
