Dear Ms. Bernardini;

The Nevada Governor's Office of Energy (GOE) oversees energy programs required through statute and those that help the mission of the office. The GOE's mission is to ensure the wise development of Nevada's energy resources in harmony with local economic needs and to position Nevada to lead the nation in renewable energy production, energy conservation, and the exportation of energy. The GOE is also the state agency that establishes the energy efficiency standards for the State of Nevada. As such, under IRS Notice 2008-35, Section 4.01(7) I would like to inform you that the Nevada GOE is an Equivalent Rating Network.

As an Equivalent Rating Network, the Nevada GOE acknowledges the use of Equivalent Calculation Procedures for eligible certifiers to calculate dwelling unit energy consumption to determine eligibility for the New Energy Efficient Home Energy Credit under Internal Revenue Code § 45L. Consistent with Section 4.01(7) of Notice 2008-35, and in reliance on the representations made to this office by EnergySoft LLC, the Nevada GOE acknowledges the use of EnergyPro software 4.7 for use in determining whether Nevada's energy efficiency standards are satisfied for purposes of the New Energy Efficient Home Energy Credit under Internal Revenue Code § 45L.

When the list of software programs specified in Section 5.01 of IRS Notice 2008-35 is next updated, the Nevada GOE requests that EnergyPro version 4.7 be included.

This office has not conducted any independent verification of EnergyPro version 4.7 or of the representations made by EnergySoft LLC, and bases this letter solely on the representations of EnergySoft LLC. This office also reserves the right to require a future independent verification of the EnergyPro software.



I hereby declare, under penalties of perjury that the software program

- (i) Has satisfied all tests required to conform to the software accreditation process prescribed in Residential Energy Services Network (RESNET) Publication No. 06-001 (June 1, 2006) and publication No. 13-001 (Jan, 2013)
- (ii) Has satisfied all tests necessary to permit a determination that the software program is sufficiently accurate to justify its use in calculating energy consumption for purposes of providing a certification under section 3 of this notice.
- (iii) Our prior version EnergyPro 4.4 has satisfied all tests required to conform to the software accreditation process prescribed in Residential Energy Services Network (RESNET) Publication No. 06-001, and pursuant to Public Law 112-240, § 408, EnergyPro 4.7 revises EnergyPro 4.4 to change the "reference house" for tax credit purposes in accordance with chapter 4 of the 2006 International Energy Conservation Code. EnergyPro 4.7 makes no other changes to EnergyPro 4.4.


