Dear Assemblyman Brooks:

Pursuant to your request for additional information at the April 26, 2017, meeting of the Governor's Committee for Energy Choice regarding the portion of monthly bills for a single family residence in Nevada that are directed toward energy efficiency programs, the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (PUCN) provides the following:

Nevada Power Company: Temporary Renewable Energy Development (TRED) + Renewable Energy Program Rate (REPR) + Energy Efficiency = 2.30% of average monthly bill in January 2017.

Sierra Pacific Power Company: Temporary Renewable Energy Development (TRED) + Renewable Energy Program Rate (REPR) + Energy Efficiency = 2.46% of average monthly bill in January 2017.
