NOTICE OF WORKSHOP TO
SOLICIT COMMENTS ON PROPOSED REGULATION

The Governor's Office of Energy (GOE) is proposing regulations pertaining to Chapter 701 of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). A workshop has been set for 1:00 p.m., on October 1, 2019, at the Governor's Office of Energy 755 N. Roop Street, Suite 202, Carson City, NV 89701 and via videoconference at the Grant Sawyer Building 555 E Washington Ave #5100, Las Vegas, NV 89101. The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics that may be addressed in the proposed regulations:

Adding in provisions pursuant to AB 54 identifying the minimum standard of general service lamps sold in the state on or before January 1, 2020 and defining general service lamp.
