NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND AGENDA

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a public hearing will be held before the Nevada Energy Director ("Director") regarding the above application at the following date, time, and location:

The hearing is being held pursuant to NRS 701A.360 (5) to determine whether the Applications filed by Techren Solar III, Techren Solar IV and Techren Solar V, with the Governor's Office of Energy ("GOE") on November 19, 2018, November 20, 2018 and November 21, 2018 respectively, for the development of solar facilities, meet the tax abatement criteria established in NRS 701A.300 through 701A.390 and adopted regulation NAC 701A.500 through 701A.660 and are, therefore, entitled to partial abatement of sales and use taxes and/or property tax as provided in NRS 701A.300 through 701A.390. The hearing shall be considered a contested case pursuant to NRS chapter 233B and shall be held and decided openly and publicly. Techren Solar III, Techren Solar IV and Techren Solar V and all other parties are entitled to present testimony of witnesses, to introduce evidence, and to cross-examine witnesses. Techren Solar III, Techren Solar IV and Techren Solar V and other parties may be represented by legal counsel of their choice.

Pursuant to NAC 701A.585, the following entities or people may participate in this hearing as a party: (1) The Director of GOE; (2) The Chief of the Budget Division of the Office of Finance; (3) The Nevada Department of Taxation; (4) The Board of County Commissioners of the county in

which the projects or facilities will be located; (5) The County Assessor of the counties in which the project or facilities will be located; (6) The County Treasurer of the counties in which the projects or facilities will be located; (7) the governing body of any city or town in which the projects or facilities are located; and (8) Governor's Office of Economic Development. Any person or entity that desires to participate as a party in the hearing of this matter must file with the Director a notice of its intention to participate in a form as described in NAC 701A.585.

The Director shall also allow public comment at a time appropriate to the conduct of the hearing.
