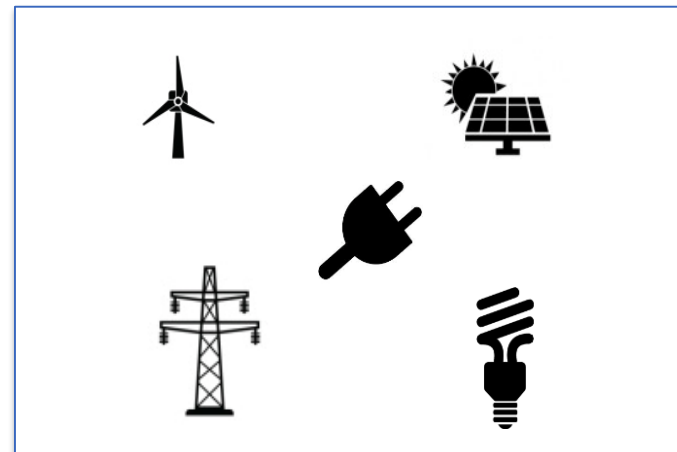

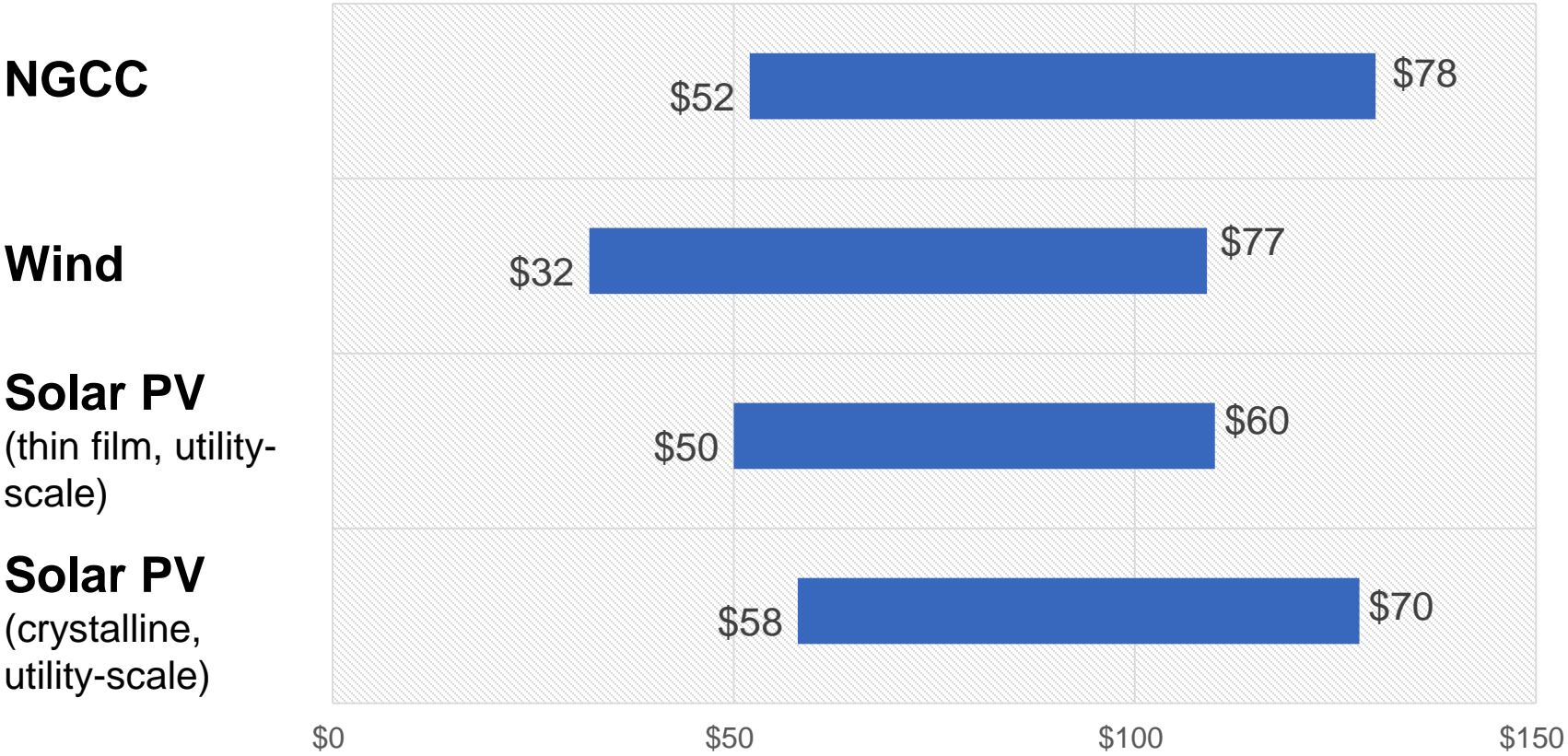
Competitive Procurement
