3. Review of the proposed adoption of IECC – 2021 IECC with the addition of EV Ready Appendices

Mrs. Yochum shared her screen and reviewed the amended formatting of the appendices. Ms. Yochum also identified that the percentages of EV Ready & EV Capable spaces in the Commercial appendices had been modified from the previous version.
